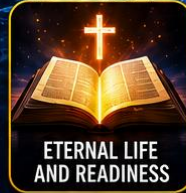

## **INTRODUCTION**

Life is full of choices, voices, distractions, and eternal consequences. Many people spend their lives chasing pleasure, success, money, entertainment, and worldly satisfaction, yet very few stop to ask where the road they are traveling will finally lead.

The Bible reminds us that there are two paths before every human being — one leading to life and the other leading to destruction. One voice calls people toward temporary pleasure, while another voice — the voice of the Messiah — calls people toward repentance, salvation, and eternal life.

What happened to me on one Friday night, changed my understanding of life forever.

It was not an ordinary dream.

It was a spiritual encounter and a divine warning.

## **THE ENCOUNTER**

That night, I saw myself inside a very large ship. It was magnificent and filled with every kind of worldly pleasure imaginable. There was loud music, entertainment, dancing, women, wine, laughter, and everything the human heart could desire.

People were enjoying themselves without restraint. Nobody wanted to think about danger. Nobody wanted to hear any warning. Everyone seemed comfortable, excited, and fully consumed by pleasure.

But the ship was moving at a very high speed toward a terrible destruction ahead — a catastrophic collision that would destroy the ship and everyone inside it.

Even though there was celebration everywhere, deep inside me I could sense that something was terribly wrong.

I remember looking toward the captain of the ship and inquiring about the warning and the danger ahead. But instead of giving a serious answer, he only gave me a comforting smile and reassuring words as if everything was under control.

Yet in my spirit, I could feel that he was hiding something.

The peace he offered did not remove the fear inside my heart.

Then I began hearing a small warning voice and a knocking again and again.

The voice urgently called out:

“Come out!  
Leave this ship!  
Board the life boat before it is too late!”

The voice was gentle, loving, but persistent.

But immediately another voice whispered:

“Do not worry.  
Stay here.

Enjoy yourself.

Eat, drink, and be merry.”

At that moment I realized there were two voices fighting for my soul.

One voice was calling me to life.  
The other was pulling me toward destruction.

Then the Scripture became real in my spirit:

“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it.”

— Matthew 7:13

I understood that the ship represented this world — full of pleasure, distractions, sin, pride, lust, greed, materialism, and temporary enjoyment.

The captain represented the false assurances of this world — voices that tell people everything is fine while hiding the reality of coming judgment.

The coming destruction represented eternal separation from God.

And the life boat represented Jesus Christ — the only Saviour and way of escape.

As I continued watching, I realized many people could hear the warnings, but they ignored them. They were too busy enjoying the pleasures around them.

It reminded me of the days of Noah when people continued eating, drinking, marrying, and celebrating while judgment was approaching.

Today the same thing is happening in our world.

Many people are so consumed with entertainment, money, pleasure, social status, and worldly success that they have no time for God.

Yet Jesus is still calling people lovingly:

“Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him...”

— Revelation 3:20

That night I understood something very deeply:

The greatest danger in life is not poverty or suffering.  
The greatest danger is living without Christ while thinking everything is fine.

Many people are smiling outwardly while their souls are drifting away from God.

Some hear the Gospel but postpone repentance.

Some know the truth but continue following worldly desires.

But the Bible warns us clearly:

“For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul?”

— Mark 8:36

Then came the turning point of my life.

That night, I surrendered my life completely to Jesus Christ and left the ship of sin behind.

I chose to listen to the voice of the Messiah instead of the voice of worldly pleasure and deception.

From that moment, my life changed forever.

The things that once seemed attractive no longer had the same power over me. I realized that without Christ, everything in this world is empty and temporary.

That night, I understood that Jesus was not merely warning me — He was rescuing me.

He was calling me out of darkness into His marvellous light.  
Out of destruction into salvation.

Out of bondage into freedom.

Out of fear into peace.

The Messiah became real to me personally.

I discovered that salvation is not about religion, traditions, or outward appearance. It is about encountering Jesus Christ and surrendering your life fully to Him.

Many people today are still inside that spiritual ship.

Some are trapped in sin.

Some are trapped in addictions.

Some are trapped in pride, lust, greed, bitterness, or unbelief.

Outwardly they appear happy, but inwardly their souls are empty and restless.

Yet Jesus is still calling:

“Come to Me, all you who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.”

— Matthew 11:28

The beautiful thing about the Messiah is this:

He does not only warn us about destruction — He provides a way of escape.

Jesus receives sinners.

He forgives.

He restores.

He gives new life.

That night became the turning point of my destiny.

And today, I thank God that I responded to His voice before it was too late.

My prayer is that everyone reading this testimony will also hear the voice of the Messiah and choose eternal life.

Because one day, the journey of this world will come to an end.

Only those who belong to Jesus Christ will stand secure forever.

## **FINAL APPEAL**

My dear friend, this testimony is more than a story.  
It is a warning, an invitation, and a message of God's mercy.

Many people today are living like passengers on that ship —  
distracted by pleasure, entertainment, money, success,  
relationships, and the cares of this world, while ignoring the  
condition of their souls.

Outwardly everything may appear normal.  
People laugh, celebrate, build, buy, and enjoy life.

But inwardly many are empty, restless, fearful, and far from God.

The truth is this:

Life without Jesus Christ is dangerous no matter how comfortable  
it may seem.

One day, every human being will stand before God.

On that day, money will not save anyone.  
Fame will not save anyone.  
Religion alone will not save anyone.

Only a true relationship with Jesus Christ can save the soul.

The Messiah is still knocking at the door of hearts today.

He is calling sinners to repentance.  
He is calling the weary to rest.

He is calling the broken to healing.  
He is calling the lost back home.

Do not ignore His voice.

The world may promise comfort like the captain of that ship, but  
only Jesus can give eternal security.

Tomorrow is not promised.

Today is the day of salvation.

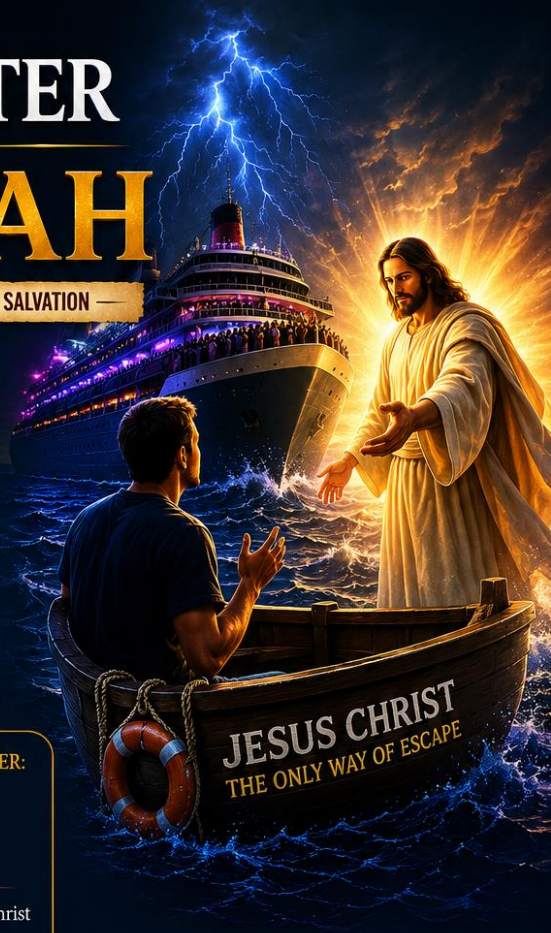
On one Friday night, a powerful spiritual encounter changed everything.

Another voice offered comfort and assurance that everything would be fine.

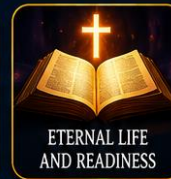
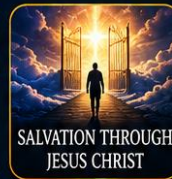
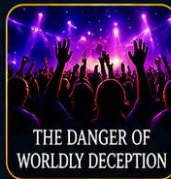
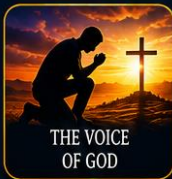
He had to make a choice.
